In October, we had the opportunity to have a representative from Dixie State University (DSU) on our campus talking to high school students about their university. Dixie State has been working with our counseling department to create an amazing opportunity for our students to travel to their university for a "Preview Weekend" in February. By attending the DSU Preview, students will get a chance to experience what it's like to be a student at DSU. It's a weekend filled with activities, interactive presentations, and much more.

Dixie State University is paying for the cost of a charter bus for some of our students to go to their university for this Preview Weekend on Friday, February 19th through Saturday, February 20th! If your student is interested going, they must fill out an application and turn in all required documentation by the Friday, January 15, 2016. Please see the attached documentation of the requirements by grade level to apply for this opportunity.

The requirements were created based on what the counseling staff sees as necessary in order for students to begin preparing for their post-secondary education. The essays required for this application can be used for your college applications and scholarship searches—so make sure to save a digital copy for yourself!

We will be selecting 6 sophomores, 20 juniors, and 10 seniors to participate in this road trip. Interviews may be conducted if the number of students who apply is more that the allotted number of students we can take. Students will be notified by Friday, January 21, 2016 if they have been selected. The total cost to parents will be \$30, which will cover the overnight stay at DSU and two meals.

Once we have selected the students, we will hold a mandatory parent meeting to discuss itinerary, rules, and to fill out permission slips. This is an experience your kids will never forget! UC Application Questions and Essay Prompts

Personal Statement Prompts: 1000 Words

- 1. Describe the world you come from for example, your family, community or school and tell us how your world has shaped your dreams and aspirations.
- 2. Tell us about a personal quality, talent, accomplishment, contribution or experience that is important to you. What about this quality or accomplishment makes you proud, and how does it relate to the person you are?

3. Additional Comments 550 words

If you wish, you may use this space to tell us anything else you want us to know about you that you have not had the opportunity to describe elsewhere in the application.

Personal Statement Instructions

The personal statement is your opportunity to introduce yourself to the people reading your application. Think of it as your interview with the admissions office. Be open, be honest and remember to talk about yourself. This will give us a better understanding of the information you present in other parts of your application.

A few tips:

- Read each prompt carefully and respond to all parts.
- Present your information and ideas in a focused, thoughtful manner. Making a list of accomplishments, activities, awards or work will lessen the impact of your words.
- Use specific, concrete examples to support the points you want to make. Focus your examples on the present and near past.
- Tell us about yourself. Your personal statement should be about you your personal triumphs or challenges, leadership opportunities and experiences outside the classroom.
- Use your own voice. The personal statement should reflect your ideas and be written by you alone. Use "I" and "my" statements in your response.
- Relax. This is one of many pieces of information we consider in reviewing your application; an admission decision will not be based on your personal statement alone.
